## The Species Of Oysters Of The Gulf, Caribbean And West Indian Region

\*Abstract

THERE ARE SPECIES of all three living genera of Ostreidae in the Gulf and West Indian region. They are Pycnodonte thomasi, Ostrea cristata, O. frons, O. permollis, Crassostrea virginica and C. rhizophorae. O. limacella seems to be synonym of frons. O. spreta is in part a synonym of cristata.
